

Allan's Simple Guide for Success with Plants

Place plants properly, in good soil with space to grow.

Look for problems frequently as pests appear suddenly.

Apply water judiciously, know soil capacity and plant needs.

Nourish plants appropriately to spur strong growth.

Trim plants regularly, don't ignore them as they grow.

Control pests naturally, w/ beneficial insects, biologicals, barriers or traps.

Anticipate hazards seasonally. Cover tender plants to prevent freezing and mulch when it's hot to conserve water.

Reduce risks initially. Buy plant varieties that have disease and insect resistance and good growth habits.

Evaluate efforts annually. If it won't do what you bought it to do or continues to have excessive disease or insect problems, then say good by to it!
