3 venues include gathering of attendees were at a variety of locations including
4 but not limited to Westlake Park (401 Pine Street), Judkins Park (2150 South
5 Norman Street) and Seattle Central Community College (1701 Broadway
6 Avenue) prior to the initiation of a march and following the completion of the
7 march.
- 8 2. Camera footage of the complete march route(s) from the above listed venues
9 during the time of the demonstrations to their respective destination.

11 Rik Hall declares:

12 1. I have served as a police officer in Seattle for over sixteen years and been assigned as a
13 detective for the past eight years. I have personal knowledge of the matters asserted in this
14 affidavit.

15 2. I am currently investigating crimes of MALICIOUS MISCHIEF, DESTRUCTION OF
16 GOVERNMENT PROPERTY (Title 18 USC Section 1361), RIOT or ASSAULT.

17 3. I was a patrol officer assigned to bicycle patrol for approximately seven years. During
18 that time, as part of my assignment and responsibilities, I worked small and large
19 demonstrations as a rapid response team/demonstration management officer. I was assigned
20 in that capacity during the World Trade Organization (WTO) riots in 1999 as well as the
21 anniversary WTO events (N30) which occurred for the next several years. During those events,
22 as well as numerous others, I had direct contact and observations of persons using tactics and
23 methods consistent with black bloc anarchism. During my current assignment as a detective, I
24 have attended training regarding anarchism as well as working cases involving persons who
25 use tactics, clothing and methods consistent with black bloc anarchism. I have observed that
26 individuals and groups who use the black bloc methodology wear a "uniform" which conceals

1 their identity and makes each person appear relatively alike; making it difficult to determine
2 which person committed the criminal act. The individual perpetrator will commit the criminal act
3 then return to their group to rapidly "mix" in order to make tracking of the individual very difficult.
4 I have observed a tactic known as "de-blocing. Individuals will arrive at a venue in "regular
5 clothes" in order to conceal their ideology. The group will then form into a huddle and put on
6 clothing and concealment to conceal their identity. They will sometimes cover the group with a
7 banner to conceal their actions. Once the criminal act is perpetrated, they will return to regular
8 clothing during the ensuing chaos.

9 4. The "Cascadian Anarchist Olympics" training was held in Olympia, Washington on April
10 20-22, 2012 listed in the schedule of events was "team de-bloc." During the May Day event on
11 May 1, 2012, "black bloc anarchists" were observed putting on their concealing clothing prior to
12 incidents and removing it afterward to as described above to thwart identification by law
13 enforcement.

14 5. On Tuesday, May 1, 2012, numerous individuals and groups staged several large
15 protests at a variety of venues in the City of Seattle, County of King, State of Washington. The
16 number of attendees during these events numbered in the thousands. Within the permitted
17 events and marches as well as the unpermitted events and marches were individuals and
18 groups who damaged private property, damaged and destroyed government property and
19 committed acts of riot and assault. Individuals within these groups used items including, but not
20 limited to, hammers, large diameter dowels, rocks, crow bars, poles, lit road flares, smoke
21 bombs, hands, fists and spray-paint. Damage to property included, but was not limited to
22 shattered windows, graffiti, damage to door and window framing. A large portion of the
23 individuals and groups that perpetrated these crimes wore similar/identical black clothing which
24 included bandannas/balaclavas/gas mask as well as eyewear to thwart law enforcement and
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1 witnesses from identifying the individuals who had performed the criminal act. This tactic is
2 consistent with black bloc anarchism.

3 6. Most retail businesses focus surveillance video toward the interior of the business, thus
4 limiting substantive footage of individuals approaching their business from the exterior. While
5 the plentiful amounts of internet video available at the time of this subpoena shows persons
6 participating in the aforementioned crimes, the affiant has been unable to locate any video that
7 shows the subjects prior to the crime, without their concealing garb. Raw footage from the
8 above listed media sources will assist in revealing the identity of the individuals responsible for
9 the felony and misdemeanor state and federal crimes listed above.

10 7. On February 8, 2012 following an unpermitted march attended by individuals dressed
11 and carrying black flags consistent with black bloc anarchism in which there had been property
12 destructions, while mid-block in the street, multiple members of the crowd broke into a run,
13 scattering and dispersing through the blocks to west of Broadway Avenue, stripping off their
14 "anarchist garb," in essence, de-blocing.

15 8. During the May 1, 2012 event, I observed multiple news stations filming what was
16 happening, their camera footage is valuable, necessary and material evidence in the further
17 investigation of this incident.


18 9. It is my belief that evidence of the crime(s) of MALICIOUS MISCHIEF, DESTRUCTION



RCW 10.79.015
Other grounds for issuance of search warrant.

Any such magistrate, when satisfied that there is reasonable cause, may also, upon like complaint made on oath, issue search warrant in the following cases, to wit:

(1) To search for and seize any counterfeit or spurious coin, or forged instruments, or tools, machines or materials, prepared or provided for making either of them.

(2) To search for and seize any gaming apparatus used or kept, and to be used in any unlawful gaming house, or in any building, apartment or place, resorted to for the purpose of unlawful gaming.

(3) To search for and seize any evidence material to the investigation or prosecution of any homicide or any felony: PROVIDED, That if the evidence is sought to be secured from any radio or television station or from any regularly published newspaper, magazine or wire service, or from any employee of such station, wire service or publication, the evidence shall be secured only through a subpoena duces tecum unless: (a) There is probable cause to believe that the person or persons in possession of the evidence may be involved in the crime under investigation; or (b) there is probable cause to believe that the evidence sought to be seized will be destroyed or hidden if subpoena duces tecum procedures are followed. As used in this subsection, "person or persons" includes both natural and judicial persons.

(4) To search for and seize any instrument, apparatus or device used to obtain telephone or telegraph service in violation of RCW 9.26A.110 or 9.26A.115.
