Mr. Mosby stated the suspect Ms. Sutton-Barnes came to the above location knocking on his door stating she needed to speak to his female friend, witness Doreen Carter who was visiting. Mr. Mosby stated he exited out the side door of his home and spoke with Ms. Sutton-Barnes, leaving Ms. Carter inside the home.

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INITIAL REPORT

Mr. Mosby stated Ms. Sutton-Barnes became upset he had a female visitor and began to try on enter into his home, trying to force herself past him into the home. He blocked the entrance to the door by standing in the doorway. He stated Ms. Sutton-Barnes continued to be aggressive and began to hit him in the chest with her fist. Mr. Mosby stated the suspect grabbed his glasses off his face and threw them into the front yard. Mr. Mosby stated he grabbed Ms. Sutton-Barnes and began to hold her against a 2006 Blue Ford Five Hundred parked in his driveway belonging to Mrs. Carter. Mr. Mosby stated Ms. Sutton-Barnes bent the front passenger side windshield wiper to the vehicle during the struggle. Mr. Mosby stated he pulled a muscle in his right leg while attempting to physically restrain the Ms. Sutton-Barnes as he placed her onto the ground restraining her. He then took her keys from her pocket and threw them into the front yard, telling her to go get her keys. Mr. Mosby stated when Ms. Sutton-Barnes went to get her keys he went back into his home and locked the door. Mr. Mosby further stated he was the campaign manager for Ms. Sutton-Barnes when she ran for office. Mr. Mosby stated he and Ms. Sutton-Barnes are in a relationship but never lived together nor do they have children together.

Officer Barnes spoke with Ms. Sutton-Barnes as she was being seen by DeKalb EMS for a left ankle injury. Ms. Sutton-Barnes told Officer Barnes she and Mr. Mosby have been in relationship for the last seven years. Ms. Sutton-Barnes stated she came to the above location and attempted to walk inside the victim's home when he grabbed her and threw her down to the ground. I observed grass and dirt on her clothing. She did not state why she was at the victim's home. Ms. Sutton-Barnes stated she does not have any personal belongings at the home.

Sgt. Pierre and Sgt. Coleman were notified of this incident and responded to the above location. South CID LT. Deloach responded to the location and took photos of Mr. Mosby and Ms. Sutton-Barnes and conducted interviews. Domestic Violence Unit, Sgt. Mercer and Det. Guess also responded to assist with the investigation. Major Jones, Captain Mears, and LT. Sheirling, also responded for further investigations.

The witness, Ms. Carter stated she only heard the knock on the door and both Mr. Mosby and Mrs. Sutton-Barnes speaking outside the residence, she did not observe any altercation.

Officer Barnes informed Ms. Sutton-Barnes of Criminal Trespass Warning upon request of Mr. Mosby. Both Mr. Mosby and Ms. Sutton-Barnes were advised of their legal rights and how to obtain warrants. Neither had visible injuries. They were provided a case number in reference to this incident.

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ADDITIONAL NARRATIVE

On 02/11/2014 at approximately 1053 hours I, Officer T. Barnes#2702, made contact with Ms. Sharon Sutton-Barnes while responding to 2457 Habersham Drive. She stated she arrived at the location because Mr. Warren Mosby agreed to assist her with getting some Kerosene for her heater on yesterday's date. She advised Mosby told her to come in the morning. Ms. Sutton-Barnes stated she attempted several times to contact Mosby upon her arrival by cell phone; however, he did not answer the phone. She stated when she arrived she knocked on the door several times but there was no response.

Ms. Sutton-Barnes advised Mr. Mosby finally came to the door and stated he was in a meeting. She noticed an additional vehicle in the driveway parked behind Mr. Mosby's vehicle. She stated Mr. Mosby advised his meeting was with Ms. Doreen Carter, an acquaintance known to Ms. Sutton-Barnes. She stated they had an argument over his meeting with Mrs. Carter. She advised she told him, "I don't want anything more to do with you." She stated she attempted to enter the residence of Mr. Mosby and was pushed out onto the driveway. She advised Mr. Mosby then continued to argue about her being at the location. She stated she got up to her feet and Mr. Mosby pushed her back down onto the driveway. She stated Mr. Mosby then threw her against the car as she was trying to run. She also stated Mr. Mosby grabbed her and she reached for his glasses during the incident. Ms. Sutton-Barnes stated Mr. Mosby then threw her between the vehicles then he took her car keys out of her pocket. She advised Mr. Mosby put his knee in her chest below her throat. She stated she could barely breathe and could not get up from his restrains. She advised he stated to her "This is why that man beat that woman in the middle of the street!" she advised he was referring to an incident she observed around the 2nd week in January. She advised there had been other incidents where she was assaulted by Mr. Mosby. Ms. Sutton-Barnes advised Mr. Mosby also stated "It's your word against mine!" She stated Mr. Mosby released her after he was going to retrieve something out of the house. She advised at the time she could not breathe and her left ankle was hurting.

I observed Ms. Sutton-Barnes with dirt all over her left side and back. She was being treated by Medic 55. Ms. Sutton-Barnes was visually upset, crying, and rubbing her chest. Her left shoe was partially off and M55 advised that her blood pressure was elevated. M55 staff advised her car keys were located in the front yard. M55 advised Ms. Sutton-Barnes to seek additional treatment due to her cardiac history. She advised she did not want to be transported.

Mr. Warren Mosby advised he did not want Ms. Sutton-Barnes back on his property. Ms. Sutton-Barnes was advised verbally not to come back to 2457 Habersham Drive. She was advised it would be deemed criminal trespass after being given a 1st warning by law enforcement. She was advised she could be arrested if found back on Mr. Mosby's property. She stated, "I'm never coming back here....trust me".

Ms. Sutton-Barnes advised she did not want to seek charges against Mr. Mosby at this time. Both parties were provided a case number and advised of the legal process. Ms. Sutton-Barnes stated she was able to drive home; she left the location without further incident.
